SUBJECT: Public Act 102-0721 Quarterly Report on Contractor-Requested Change Orders Involving Price

The Illinois Department of Transportation has established a quarterly report for contractor-requested change orders involving price in accordance with Public Act 102-0721, which went into effect on January 1, 2023.

The report is intended to provide information regarding change order requests concerning price that have been received by the Department within the applicable reporting quarter and have not been acted upon within 45 days after their receipt. We are prepared to submit these reports to the General Assembly and publish them on our website each quarter for the duration of the period established by the public act.

The legislation requires the first quarterly report to be published by the department on or before January 15, 2023; therefore, a copy of the first report is enclosed for your use. (Note, there is no data to report for the time period between the act's effective date of January 1, 2023 and the first report submittal date of January 15, 2023. Future status reports will include data collected over full quarterly time periods.)

The Illinois Department of Transportation is committed to making sure that potential contract changes are communicated effectively and that change requests are acted upon in a timely fashion.
